God can be Trusted.

*"Let us hold tightly without
wavering to the hope we affirm,
for God can be trusted to keep
His promise."*

Hebrews 10:23 (NLT)

Dear Beloved,

In times of uncertainty, disappointment, or delay, it is more important than ever to hold on to this foundational truth: God can be trusted. Let us take a closer look at the scripture above and see what the Holy Spirit will help us uncover and learn.

What is the hope we affirm?

It is our unshakable confidence in God's faithfulness — that He will save, deliver, provide, heal, restore, and fulfill every word He has spoken over our lives. This hope points us to eternal life, gives us strength for today, and assurance for tomorrow.

As Scripture reminds us, "Christ in us, the hope of glory" (Colossians 1:27). Our hope is not built on circumstances but on the living Christ within us —

the One who guarantees both our present help and our eternal inheritance.

Why must we hold tightly to it?

Because life will test that hope. There will be moments when prayers seem unanswered and the wait feels long. In those times, we are urged not to loosen our grip. Our faith is not based on what we see, but on who we know — a God who never fails.

What can God be trusted for?
